### Validity:

- On June 15, 2023, during the In Port Section of the Leg 7, on leg 4 in between marks 3 and 4 a collision between Guyot on port and 11<sup>th</sup> Hour Racing on starboard occurred.
- Holcim was immediately aware of the collision between 11th Hour Racing and Guyot.
- Holcim did not display a red flag after she was aware of the incident.
- Holcim informed 11<sup>th</sup> Hour Racing by phone to Bill Erkelens on the June 28, 2023 in the morning about her intention to protest.
- Holcim informed Race Committee about her intention to protest 11<sup>th</sup> Hour Racing on June 28, 2023 in the morning.
- Last boat finished Leg 7 on June 27, 2023.

### Fact Founds:

#### Conclusion:

Holcim, protesting under rules of Part 2, was not involved in the incident between 11<sup>th</sup> Hour Racing and Guyot. The requirements to protest under Appendix UF 3.3(a) are not met.
