



Answer:

Boat P is disqualified. She fails to keep clear of Boat S under rule 10, On Opposite Tacks. Rules 18.1(a) and 18.1(b), Mark-Room: When Rule 18 Applies states that rule 18 does not apply when boats are on opposite tacks on a beat to windward, or when the proper course at the mark for one but not both of the boats is to tack. Clearly P does not need to tack to sail her proper course (i.e., to finish as quickly as possible; see the definition Proper Course). But S and P are both on a "beat to windward" because they are sailing to an upwind mark and the reason they are not both sailing close-hauled courses is because P has overstood the close-hauled layline to the mark. Therefore rule 18 does not apply and P must keep clear of S under rule 10, which she fails to do. (See World Sailing Case 132.)
