Kenetic V: Slight, Scattered, 050 11kts, 1015

Blue Flash: Cloudy skies, swell 1-3ft, tws 12, twd 018, 1017.0.
Quote of the trip: "Bill, I'm confused" which was uttered by a certain 19 year old bowman who shall remain nameless after waking up in our coffin berth in the middle of the night and forgetting how to get himself out of it to go on watch.

Raisin' Cane: Seas 2-4 feet, sky mostly clear with clouds, Winds 056 Magnetic, 17 kts, 1019.1

Medusa: 16% puffy clouds, wind 14 kn @ 056 degrees, 1011mb and falling
Either we are "smelling the barn", or it smells like a barn in here;)

Triumph: Sea 2-3' sky 50% overcast, wind dir 050(mag), velocity 17-knts, 1018.4MB
Crew reporting essence of mai tai's in the air.

Prevail: Squalls everywhere! Skies dark & stormy, wind 13 knots @ 40 degrees
between systems.

Dark Star: We finally found where they've been keeping all the squalls. Currently in the midst of our 9th of the evening. Winds to 30kts and rain. Not much sleep but they've been propelling us up the course nicely. Talk about earning your finish. Our objective is to issue tomorrow's 0800 position report from a beach in Waikiki with Mai Tais in hand. Aloha!

Tropic Thunder: Sea and Sky Conditions: 2-4 ft partly cloudy, TWD 043 TWS 18 1018.3MB
A2 up and down a few times as wind crossed its safe range, Heavy Rain squall around 7-7:30 wind gust over 30 but sustained well below 30. The A2 survived but was dowsed to be better prepared if another one came. Daylight brought stable wind.
