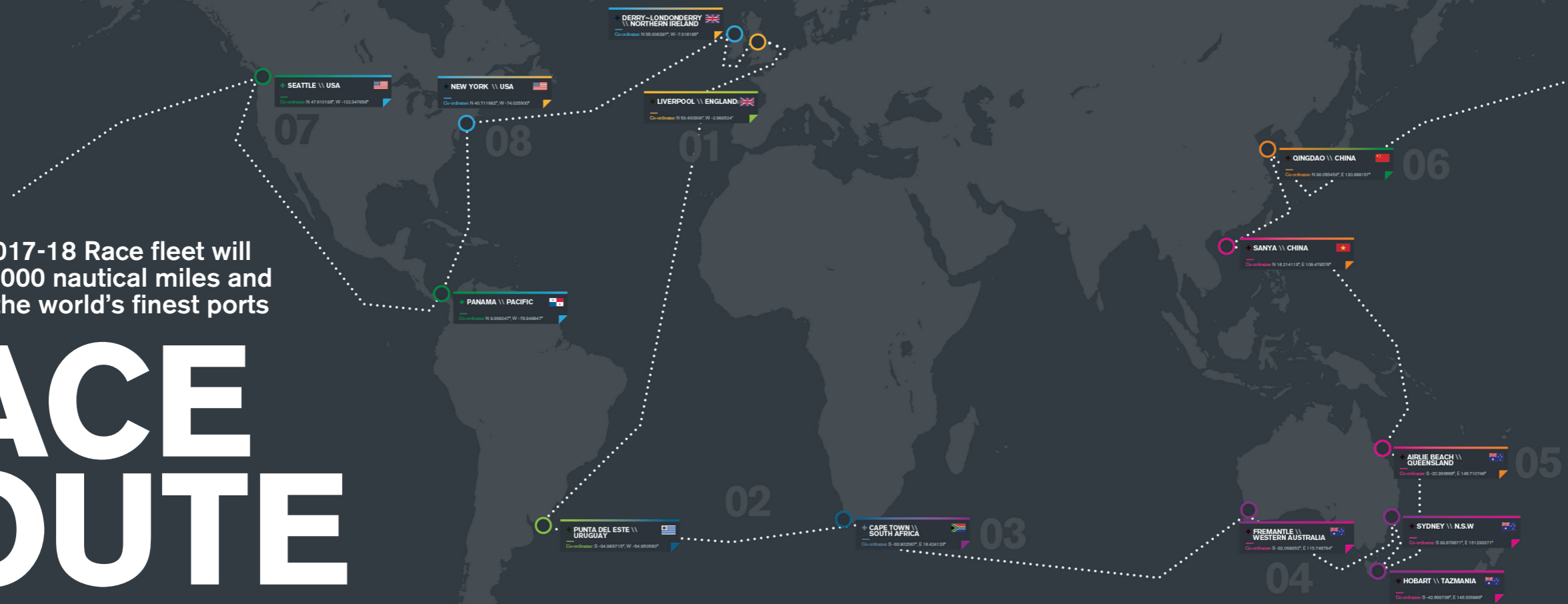


The Clipper 2017-18 Race fleet will travel over 40,000 nautical miles and visit some of the world's finest ports
