San Diego Yacht Club Stop – October 5 - 6, 2019
Long Beach Yacht Club Stop – November 2 - 3, 2019

Notice of Series

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) will be each of the three clubs with events in the series.

2. SCHEDULE

The California Dreamin' Series (CDS) will consist of three match racing events: the St. Francis Yacht Club Stop on March 9 - 10, 2019 in J/22 type boats, the San Diego Yacht Club Stop on October 5 - 6, 2019 in J/22 type boats, and the Long Beach Yacht Club Stop on November 2 - 3, 2019 in Catalina 37 type boats.

3. RULES

The Notices of Race and Sailing Instructions of each event shall apply.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Any skipper entered in at least one of the three events is automatically entered in the CDS. There is no entry fee for the CDS. **Skippers who enter multiple stops shall be given first priority for entry acceptance at each stop.**

4.1 Up to eight (8) skippers will be invited to each Stop of the CDS. Skippers may request invitations to one or more of the Qualifying events.

4.2 The application period for all Qualifying events opens on December 15, 2018. Skippers may request invitations to individual qualifying events online by clicking on the link at:

4.3 The CDS Invitation Committee will also consider a skipper's:

(a) Match racing results and sailing resume

(b) Proximity to event venue (OA may give preference to skippers traveling more than 500 km to assist in event grading)

(c) Need to fill available qualifying slots at each event

5. SCORING

5.1 Skippers shall receive points as noted below based on their finish in each of the three (3) events in the CDS. If a skipper does not enter an event, they shall receive zero (0) points for that event. Event points shall be applied based on the schedule below. The final series score shall be based on the highest total of event points, counting the best two of three event scores for a skipper. **The Long Beach Yacht Club Stop shall be counted as one of the two scored events.** The skipper with the highest series score shall be declared the winner of the CDS.

5.2 If a series tie exists between two or more boats, they shall be ranked in order of their scores in the Long Beach Yacht Club Stop. This changes RRS A8.

6. PRIZES

The principal prize for the winner of the CDS will be an invitation to the 2020 Ficker Cup.
