
The objective is to:

- Get people sailing in a fully-crewed environment (youth and women)
- Along two of the three French coastlines each year,
- On a One Design platform (Figaro Beneteau 3)
- And using various events of different levels with which to prepare

A flagship event - TOUR VOILE

- multi-disciplinary (windward-leewards, coastal, overnight),
- intense,
- competitive,
- 'low-cost'
- with a low carbon footprint
- over the first two weeks of July every year





Who is this for?


Several stakeholders:

- Youth (under 26)
- Women
- Amateurs (WS Status)
- Professionals
- Non-French crews

Four crew on board at all times with at least two under 26 and with at least one women. Rotation of crews over the period of the event encouraged as long as the above quota is respected.



- 2023 Channel & Atlantic
- 2024 Med & Channel or Atlantic
- 2025 Med & Atlantic or Channel
- 2026 Channel & Atlantic
- Use of fleets already on site for other events
- No transporting of boats for just one event
- Use of direct SNCF train routes to move from the Med to the other coastline (EG Marseille-Le Havre)




How to get involved

- Option 1a & 1b. A typical Figaro skipper can collaborate with other people or groups to compete in the TOURVOILE.
- **Option 2.** A skipper/group/club etc can charter a boat for an extended period, to train and compete in part or in all of the Figaro circuit (including TOURVOILE).
- **Option 3a & 3b.** A skipper/group/club etc can charter a boat for a short period for training and the TOURVOILE.



Option 1a March-July

- Collaboration type
 - Classic Figaro project where the addition of a TOUR VOILE budget is made to the initial skipper's project.
 - Training sessions and fully crewed events (Spi Ouest, ArMen, Tour Voile).
- Budget (6):
- 30-45K Euros (excluding VAT)





Option 1b March/mid-April & Mid-June/mid-July)

- Collaboration type
 - Classic Figaro project where the addition of a TOUR VOILE budget is made to the initial skipper's project.
 Boat not available during the Transat Paprec.
 - Training sessions and fully crewed events (Spi Ouest, Tour Voile).
- Budget (8):
 - 18K-25K Euros (excluding VAT)





Option 2 January-September

- Collaboration type.
 - A team, or a duo, prepare the entire Figaro season including singlehanded, two-handed and fully-crewed events. (Transat Paprec, TourVoile and Solitaire).
- Budget (1):
 - 120K 220K Euros (excluding VAT)



Option 3a - Mid-June/mid-July

- Collaboration type: A team prepares for the TOUR VOILE with minimal training and no early season regattas
- Budget (8):
 - 15K 20K Euros (excluding VAT)



Option 3b February-July

- Collaboration type
 - A team prepares its own high-end project for the TOUR VOILE with training and early season regattas (Spi Ouest, Ar Men & TourVoile Fastnet/Guy Cotten)
- Budget (8):
 - •50K 100K Euros (excluding VAT)







Year round training

- Two-handed and fully-crewed training sessions (Academies) organised by the various French training centres (in collaboration with the FFV) from the beginning of the year to the beginning of the summer.
- Two-handed and fully-crewed events are already within the class' annual programme - from Easter through the summer. (Spi Ouest France 1-10 April & Ar Men Race 17-20 May).
- With the growth of the class' activities there are even possibilities for Med-based teams to train in the Med from 2023 before travelling to the TOUR VOILE start.




Year round training and racing for fully-crewed teams

- Training sessions organised in La Rochelle, La Trinité and Lorient from February 2023
- Spi Ouest France La Trinité
 - 2-5 April Offshore race (200-400 miles)
 - Up to two starts
 - 7-10 April Inshore and round the cans racing
 - Up to 10 starts
- Ar Men Race La Trinité
 - 15-17 May Structured training/coaching
 - 18-19 May Offshore Race (140 miles)
 - 20 May Round the cans racing
 - Up to 2 starts
- TourVoile Channel & Atlantic coastlines
 - 26-28 June Structured training/coaching
 - 30 June-15 July TourVoile
 - •Up to 25 starts
- Figaro Nationals TBD
 - 2-5 October Structured training/coaching
 - 6-8 October Inshore and coastal racing
 - Up to 10 starts









PART 1 - Tour de Bretagne à la Voile (hosting TOUR VOILE Part 1)
1-9 July


- Always 30+ entries for this two-handed event.
- Organised by the Ligue de Bretagne every odd year.
- Mix of racing types round the cans, coastal, offshore, overnight.
- Four ports
- Two divisions two-handed and fully-crewed (4)
- Only the fully-crewed division can compete in the TOUR VOILE event.



Part 2 - Atlantic Seaboard 10-14 July

- Limited to the fully-crewed teams in Part 1.
- Organised by *TBC:
- Mix of racing types round the cans, coastal, offshore, overnight.
- Three-four ports (*St Gilles, Port Joinville, Les Sables, La Rochelle, Royan)
- Fully-crewed only





Sails & Branding

- The sails used during the TOUR VOILE shall be "used" sails as defined in the Figaro Class Rule (having already done several events not new)
- One sail per boat may be supplied (and branded) by the organisation.
- The Tour Voile organiser reserves the base of the mainsail (3m x 1.5m) for event partner branding
- Otherwise branding is as defined in the Figaro Class OD rules (Appendix 9)



Operational and logistics efficiency

- There will be a grouped shore crew for the whole fleet (van and spares trailer plus one preparateur for every four boats)
- Teams' bagage shall be transported by the organisation (no ground transport required)
- All meals shall be supplied by the event
- Fuel tanks shall be full at the beginning of the event and collectively refilled as and when required.
- Safety checks and scrutineering shall be made by each of the teams (one team checks another teams' equipment by draw)





TOUR VOILE - The future

In the future - an international angle

- This event lends itself perfectly to become an international championship.
- To date there are 8 countries expressing interest that are currently already in the Figaro class (USA, IRL, GBR, BEL, ESP, SUI, ITA, GER, FRA).
- Youth, women and mixed crews lend themselves well to international federations
